This very pale whisky starts with aromas of mash, barley, hay and old flowers followed by fresh fruits. Bananas combine with peach and melon in condensed milk. Add a few raisins too. There's a pleasantly heady sweetness - vanilla, honey, (buttery) fudge, milk chocolate and coconut. The taste is spicy (white pepper), sweet (honey, cream, fruit salad) and fresh (sappy, juicy) with a drying finish. Adding water brings it to life - heady and rich (dunnage warehouse) banana and honey on buttered toast with brown sugar. Followed by orange marmalade, honey nut cornflakes and peaches in syrup. Take a sip and light spices emerge with vanilla in creamy hot milk, fresh fruits and pencil shavings. Also a chilli pepper sweetness without the heat. **Delicious!**

The smell of burning driftwood combined with salted toffee and liquorice before taking on the charred character of barbequed orange and sausages. Salty seaweed created an interesting interplay with peanut brittle before taking on a suggestion of fruit with cherry chocolates. Ginger cake and rum introduced spicy notes that formed into aniseed and rye bread. Thick cut marmalade brought rich fruit that echoed fine warm Cognac and developed a singed note like burnt raisins in a fruitcake. Charred spice rounded out the palate with hint of cinder toffee rolled in ash and fresh ginger.

Our noses got sherbet, orange peel and lemon drizzle cake before something earthier arrived (moist tobacco leaf, polished wood, leather, hay lofts, bodegas). The palate is similar – honeycomb, blood orange and rhubarb rock brightness – but waxed jackets, tea tree oil, pine resin and custard tarts gave it delightful gravitas. On the reduced nose – hibiscus and blackcurrant fruit-tea led to waxed wood, lino cuts, linseed oil, coconut husks, hazelnuts and old furniture. The palate is now balanced orange blossom and fruit bars with Demerara, peppery nasturtiums, sultanas, prunes and sherry rancio. Transferred to a first-fill PX butt after 27 years in an Oloroso butt.

The warming spice of ginger and nutmeg blended with dried leaves on a forest floor that heralded a requirement for cake. A sticky fruitcake mix was abundant with sultanas, dates and dried apricots whilst a plethora of crystalised fruits joined with glace cherries and a dash of orange oil. A thick slab of marzipan sat beside rhubarb crumble and plum tarts, dusted with demerara sugar and a sprinkling of crushed pecans. The palate introduced a zesty fizz reminiscent of lime marmalade and grapefruit with a pleasing mouthfeel of wax and extra virgin olive oil. A relaxing bed of spice brought Jamaican ginger cake and rye whisky, bound in jasmine tea, vanilla and oak sawdust.

The Panel found this one a punchy, lean and mineralic dram to begin. Clean gorse bush aromas were joined by ripe peaches, wild flowers, fruity chillies and fresh citrus zests. Water brings rosemary, gooseberry jam and citrus curds. The freshness remains beautifully pronounced. In mouth it arrives with flints, chalk, lime jelly, sandstone and rubbed mint leaf. Then coal dust, juniper wood and hints of ointment. Reduction enhances the gravelly aspects and brings notes of sandalwood, wet rocks, wool and wood grilled mackerel. A lime and herb themed finish rounds things off with aplomb.

As soon as we poured the sample a salty, sweet, smoky maritime aroma immediately filled the room - like smoked herring in a sour cream sauce made with apple vinegar, chives and mustard. Smoke and sweetness perfectly balanced on the palate like a 'smoky spotted dick' (pudding made with suet and dried fruits) served with custard – a smoky version doesn't really exist, but it does now! With a drop of water the scent from a nearby peat fire reached us on the quayside where we were mending lobster pots. During a well-earned break we sucked oysters with a sweet soy and ginger dressing.
